### **WAG Event Finals 2023**

All USAG WAG Levels 1 – 10 competitors will have an opportunity to qualify for Event Finals in their respective Level. Athletes will qualify with apparatus scores obtained during competition on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. Athletes will return on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> June to compete in the Event Finals Session, on the apparatus for which they qualified. A gymnast may qualify for Event Finals on more than one piece of apparatus.

#### **How It Works**

At the end of each USAG Level of competition (Level 1 – 10), the results for all competitors, regardless of age, on each apparatus will be placed in descending order. The six (6) highest-ranked gymnasts on each apparatus will be invited to move forward to the **Event Finals** on **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> June (Levels 1 – 5)**.

Additionally, for **USAG Levels 6 – 10** an athlete must attain a minimum mobility score of 8.5 on the apparatus during the qualifying session in order to qualify to Event Finals.

The names of the qualifying gymnasts will be confirmed at the end of the award presentation at each session. This information will also be posted on the TTGF's Facebook page during the day on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. The Club Heads will be responsible for communicating with their qualifying gymnasts and will confirm the gymnasts' acceptance of their Event Finals spot before leaving the competition venue on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June.

At the **Event Finals** session on **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> June**, **National Event Champions** who place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> on each apparatus, in each Level will be awarded.

Ties in the Event Finals will not be broken.
